- 5) Review of Publicly-Owned Land in Norwich: Francis continued the discussion if maps showing lands owned by the Norwich Fire District. Members discussed attributes of various parcels and their potential for affordable housing development. Some attention was paid to a property impacted by the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) at the intersection of Turnpike and New Boston Rd and the Barrett Playground (bread oven) property, and a Fire District property on Dutton Hill Rd (wastewater suitability is unknown).
