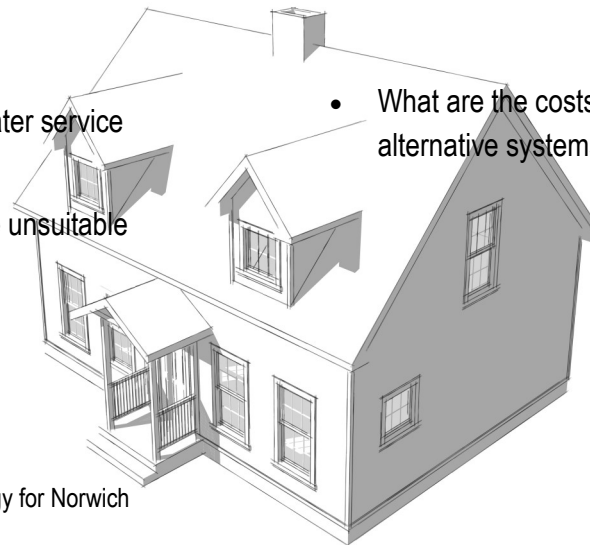
Speakers:

Terry Shearer BS, Regional Engineer ANR DEC Drinking and Groundwater Protection Division, Springfield. Terry issues permits for non-public water systems and wastewater systems of less than 6,500 gpd. His experience includes working on water sanitation projects in Honduras while a member of the Peace Corps.

Jesse Hills, Chair Cobb Hill Operations Committee. Jesse has been in charge of the Phoenix composting toilet system for the past 6 years, and heads the work teams that help maintain Cobb Hill CoHousing.

- What are the options for providing wastewater service to multiple dwelling units?
- Can alternative systems open up otherwise unsuitable land for residential development?
- What are the costs for permitting, constructing and maintaining alternative systems?
