

Minutes of the Milton Frye Nature Area Committee for May 6, 2015

Present: George Clark, Phyllis Katz, Lindsay Putnam

This meeting was primarily concerned with funding prospective professional licensed assistance as part of ongoing efforts to control invasive plants in the Norwich nature area. Initial estimates suggest a cost for these outside professional services to be cumulatively likely on the order of \$5000.

Applications for funding have already been submitted to two local organizations.

A illustrated flyer for public distribution is to be prepared to assist in requesting donations and especially from those who regularly use the nature area.

Three more potential organizations for provision of funding were discussed, and a draft application was partially prepared for one of these.

The MFNAC plans to hold a spring bird walk for the public in the nature area on Saturday morning May 23. Donations in support of invasive plant control on the nature area can be made by participants at that event.
