Infra-red, motion-detecting wildlife cameras were made ready for deployment along Town roadsides where wildlife habitat-use models have predicted potential-corridor road-crossings. The cameras are being used to help document where the wildlife are actually crossing roads. Each of the commissioners present at the meeting will deploy and monitor one of the cameras.
