D. Hobson reported on the activities of the invasive plants committee: one species a month in paper publications, speakers in spring and early summer and other posts in the DailyUV and ListServe.

L. Michaelides suggested serialize the posts online (e.g. introduce a species, where did it originate, what is it doing, how can it be controlled; spring knotweed, summer knotweed; early summer wild parsnip to be cut, midsummer wild parsnip not to be cut, etc...). C. Rimmer reported that a quarterly column in the Norwich Times on invasive plants would cost \$250 per half-page per quarter. C. Rimmer will draft some copy for the 2nd Norwich Times of 2016. March 1st is the target date for starting the online series. C. Layne will draft some copy and topics for the ListServe.

P. Silberfarb motioned (N. Miller 2nd) that the Selectboard earmark FEMA Charles Brown Brook funds to clean up old dam from the streamside, make safe the area and restore the stream and surrounding riparian corridor to a natural state, if they are not used to rebuild a dam, approved unanimously.
