## Zero-Sort Recycling

## Acceptable: (All items must be clean and dry)

- Cardboard: Cereal boxes, pasta boxes, shoe boxes, pizza boxes
- Paper: Newspapers, junk mail, envelopes, catalogs, soft cover books, telephone books, brown bags, magazines and inserts
- Plastics: Containers #1-#7 (milk jugs, bleach detergent, shampoo bottles) and Rigids (laundry baskets and buckets)
- Glass: Bottles and containers (any color)
- Metal: Aluminum, tin, steel containers (pie plates / trays / foil)

## Not Acceptable:

- Window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, dishes, Pyrex, ceramics
- Juice boxes
- Foam packaging, Styrofoam, plastic bags
- Recyclables containing food waste, paint or oils
- Hazardous material or universal waste

**\*\*** These are the guidelines for Zero-Sort Recycling. If, at any time, you have a question about whether or not a material is recyclable, or where an item should go at the Transfer Station, please ask the Transfer Station attendants who are on duty. They are knowledgeable and ready to assist residents whenever the Transfer Station is open.
