

Norwich Recreation Guidelines:

For our on-line registration, please go to www.norwich.vt.us Departments – Recreation, then “On-Line Registration’. After registering on-line, if paying by check, one can drop check off at Tracy Hall, **payable to “Town of Norwich - Recreation” or mail** to:

You will be contacted if a class is canceled or full.

Senior Citizens (70 & over) are eligible for a 15% discount upon request and proof of age.

Non-residents please note: For Adult and Instructional programs non-residents are always *welcome*. We charge a slightly higher non-resident fee – see program listings. For K - 6th grade seasonal sports, non-residents are permitted to join our program if their town does NOT offer a program, and if the numbers work to add more participants. You will be contacted after the registration deadline only if we cannot fit you in.

Refund Policy: The program fee, less \$10 will be returned if participants attend only one, or no classes, and call or write to request it. This amount can also be used as a credit toward our other programs. We cannot provide any refunds for Circus Camp or Babysitting.

Late Fee for Youth Sports: An additional \$10 is charged after our registration deadlines for most seasonal sports.

Zero Tolerance Policy: As part of the Upper Valley Recreation Association, Norwich adheres to the Zero Tolerance Policy. Please keep any comments positive when watching games.

Scholarships: The Norwich Recreation Council would like to include all resident children in its seasonal sports programs for which we have volunteer coaches. For other programs, some fees are negotiable. Any parents who would like to discuss a scholarship for their child should contact the Recreation Director @ 649-3040 x.5. If you have completed the paperwork and qualify for the school free lunch program, please mention this. All such communication will be kept strictly confidential.
