COMMITTEE ON TOWN COMMUNICATIONS

A new Committee on Town Communications for the Town of Norwich has been created and approved by the Selectboard. There are up to seven available open positions (with a minimum of three) available to Norwich members of the public at large, appointed by the Selectboard. The role of the Committee is to make recommendations to the Selectboard regarding improving two-way communications between townspeople and their government. The Committee will be in charge of making a Final Report to be presented to the Selectboard.
