The Norwich Trails Committee is to hold its monthly meeting at 7:00 PM on Wednesday May 4, 2016, at the Norwich Historical Society (corner of Main and Elm).

The initial item on the agenda is a discussion with staff of the Appalachian Trail Conservancy and potentially other agencies about the Appalachian Trail corridor through Norwich. Among topics to be addressed is the multiple trail and access point situation in the vicinity of Cossingham Road.

In whatever time remains, other items which might be considered for the agenda include a) status of the Blue Ribbon Trail reroute, b) plans for upcoming work on the Gile Mountain Trail, c) status of a proposed Norwich "loop trail", d) reports on trail conditions, and e) general issues concerning trails.
