

The Norwich Trails Committee is to hold its monthly meeting at 7:00 PM on Wednesday September 6, 2017, at the Norwich Historical Society (corner of Main and Elm Streets).

Potential items for the agenda include 1) standards and practices for trail maintenance with special attention to the Ballard Trail (including condition of treadway, stream crossings, and trail width), 2) fall projects, 3) scheduling two work sessions, 4) moving ahead with the subcommittee on signage, 5) prospective Blood Brook crossings and permit requirements, 6) spreadsheet for recording volunteer hours in trail work, 7) updates on plans, field surveys, and construction for proposed new trails and reroutes, 8) any other old business, and 9) any new business.
