

The Norwich Trails Committee is to hold its monthly meeting at 7:00 PM on Wednesday May 2, 2018, at the Norwich Historical Society (corner of Main and Elm Streets).

Potential agenda items include 1) update on mapping project from the signage subcommittee to include reports on contacts with landowners, 2) reports of recent or current trail blockages and actions taken or planned, 3) brief report on April 28 inspection walk of the Heyl Trail, 4) update on trails in mud season, 5) updates on plans, field surveys, and construction for proposed new trails and reroutes, 6) funding applications recently submitted or planned, 7) selection of dates for upcoming work sessions, 8) any other old business, and 9) any new business.

The Norwich Trails Committee provides review, planning, and work for the construction, maintenance, use, and mapping of Norwich Trails open to the public. Members of the public are cordially invited to attend and participate in the meetings and trail work sessions of the committee.

On April 28 the committee is to hold an inspection walk on the Heyl Trail with participants meeting at 9 AM at the Elm Street trailhead.

Please note that at this time the Gile Mountain Trail and numerous other town trails remain closed for mud season.
