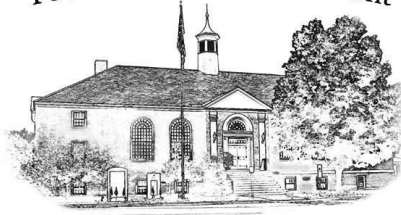

The Town of Norwich, Vermont seeks candidates for the Director of Planning & Zoning. This is a full-time position responsible for supporting the Planning Commission in drafting and implementing the Town Plan; drafting, administering and enforcement of land use regulations, and providing professional technical support to the Planning Commission, Development Review Board, and Historic Preservation Commission. Public presentation, writing, and communication skills are important for this position.

Minimum qualifications include a bachelor's degree in planning, community development, public administration, or a related field – supplemented by three years of progressively responsible experience in zoning, planning and/or community development; or, an equivalent combination of education and experience.

The position reports to the Town Manager, includes a comprehensive benefit package, and has a salary range of \$64,165 to \$66,757 (July 1), based on experience and demonstrated skills.

Norwich is located along the Connecticut River across from Hanover, NH and Dartmouth College. With a population of about 3,400 persons, Norwich has an historic village, excellent schools, extensive recreation trails, and a village green.
