

PLEASE NOTE SPECIAL DATE AND LOCATION FOR THE JULY TRAILS MEETING.

The Norwich Trails Committee is to hold its monthly meeting at 7:00 PM on Wednesday July 11, 2018, in the upstairs Conference Room at Tracy Hall. The committee ordinarily meets on the first Wednesday of each month, but in view of the Independence Day holiday, the meeting in July is to be a week later than usual. This change of date has necessitated a change in the meeting site.

Potential agenda items include 1) brief report on the June 24 Gile Mountain Trail work session, 2) Brownschoolhouse Road bridge collapse, 3) other recent or current trail blockages and actions taken or planned, 4) the Betty Booth Trail, 5) trail mapping, 6) upcoming Ballard Trail bridge repairs and a new bog bridge on the Ballard Trail, 7) planning for the Trails Committee work session on August 5, 8) wildlife use of an area south of Bragg Hill Road, 9) town trails and the Appalachian Trail corridor, 10) special joint meeting of the Conservation Commission and the Trails Committee to be arranged, 11) anticipated new quarterly reports to include, in part, list of committee members and lists for current and planned projects, 12) any other old business, and 13) any new business.

The Norwich Trails Committee provides review, planning, and work for the construction, maintenance, use, and mapping of Norwich Trails open to the public. Members of the public are cordially invited to attend and participate in the meetings and trail work sessions of the committee.
