

**Green Up Day May 4, 2019**  
**Town of Norwich VT**

Residents can participate in the Green Up Day activities on May 4 in the Town of Norwich. The details:

1. Green Up Day is May 4, 2019 from 8:00 AM to 12:00PM
2. Trash bags can be picked up at Tracy Hall at the Town Clerk's office during normal office hours for the Town Clerk (M – F, 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM). Additional bags can be picked up at the Transfer Station on Wednesdays and Saturdays before Green Up Day and on May 4, 2019 during Green Up Day hours. When picking up the trash bags, you can select the street for your trash pickup on the Town route map (see Town Clerk for map).
3. Trash bags are to be filled only with trash which is not prohibited by the trash collection agency. Please see below for those prohibited items.
4. Trash bags can be left at the end of the street (at the intersection of the adjoining street) on the shoulder of the road – not on the road.
5. Trash bags can also be brought to the Norwich Transfer Station between 8:00 AM and 12:00 PM on Green Up Day only. The bags will be placed in a special Green Up Day dumpster.
6. The Public Works Department shall collect the trash bags on Monday May 6, 2019 between 7:00 AM and 3:30 PM.

- Monitors	Lead
- Keyboards	Medical Waste
- Printers	Propane Tanks
- Fax machines	Paints
- Copiers	Tires
- Scanners/radios	Yard Waste (bagged leaves/brush)
