Norwich, VT has an opening for its Director of Public Works. Under the direction of the Town Manager, this is a full-time, salaried position responsible for supervision of Highway, Transfer Station, Custodial, and Buildings & Grounds functions.

The Director is expected to:

- Manage all aspects of the department including budget and capital budget development/implementation in a fiscally constrained environment
- Lead a DPW crew covered by a union contract
- Communicate effectively with a diverse set of stakeholders including the DPW crew and the Selectboard
- Demonstrate a commitment to continuous improvement in service quality, productivity, safety, and workplace culture
- Develop the asset management program
- Implement a comprehensive safety/risk management program
- Be an active member of a small management team dedicated to delivering high quality services in a fiscally responsible manner
- Collaborate with the Norwich Fire District (which operates a small potable water system servicing the village)
- Engage with state and regional stakeholders (including VTTrans) to obtain grant support for Norwich projects and further the goals of the town

Minimum qualifications: A combination of education, training and experience equivalent to ten years. Experience working in Northern New England an advantage. Valid driver's license required, a CDL is preferred. Enthusiasm for further professional development is appreciated. Salary is commensurate with experience; the Town offers excellent benefits.
