DRAFT MINUTES OF THE NORWICH CEMETERY COMMISSION
January 25th, 2023

Members Present: Emily Myers, Dan Goulet and Bonnie Munday (acting to fill spot temporarily)

- 1.) The meeting was called to order at 2:08 p.m in Tracy Hall.
- 2.) Since the last meeting of June 8th, 2022 Cemetery Commission member Robert Parker has resigned from his position.
- 3.) There was general discussion the future of the Cemetery Commission. The topics identified were: The likelihood of needing to hire a new Sexton, the upkeep of current cemeteries, the likely need to expand the Hillside cemetery area to make more space for graves (including green burials), and the empty Cemetery Commission positions.
- 4.) The Commission is expecting S&S Ground to mow the Hillside and Union Village Cemeteries starting before Memorial Day weekend, but will verify in the next few months.
- 5.) The Commission will ask Fred Smith to see if he is willing to mow Fairview, Beaver Meadow, New Boston, Meeting House and Waterman Hill cemeteries this summer.
- 6.) The Commission plans to meet again shortly after Town Meeting this March.
- 7.) A motion to adjourn made by Goulet, seconded by Myers to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 2.50 p.m.
