5. Zoning District Boundary Changes

- Commercial District Existing Commercial/Industrial District to remain commercial with a provision for affordable residential PUDs.
- West Side of Route 5 South Existing Rural Residential District to be changed to Mixed Use District. Still to be determined are balance between commercial and residential, basic density calculation and density bonuses for affordable housing.
- River Road Proposed River Road Mixed Use District will be expanded to
 include remainder of Cook property to the south, the east side of River Road, and
 the Dartmouth College Lewiston property. The VR II District south of Church
 Street west of I-91, and east of the Village will be included in the Mixed Use
 District.
- A revised draft zoning district map will be prepared for the next meeting.

6. Work Schedule

• The Clerk distributed a draft Meeting/Workshop Schedule extending to February 2017. Included was zoning and town plan revisions and public workshops. Changes were discussed including moving initial workshops to later in October.

7. Town Plan Update

- Norwich Town Plan expires at end of 2016 and will need to be readopted with some changes in the energy and land use sections to comply with statutes.
