Genevieve reported that the movement of Elizabeth mine tailings to a new on-site location, part of the large clean-up project, is tentatively scheduled to begin in November.

Dan, Genevieve, Peter and Brian reported that the Norwich section of the source-to-sea clean-up went well. 13 people, 4 boats and 2 trucks moved hundreds and hundreds of pounds of garbage from the Ompompanoosuc River to Ledyard bridge section of the Connecticut River to the transfer station on 3 October. Coordination of efforts in 2010 with the King Arthur's Flour clean-up crew was discussed. Also discussed was the possibility of involving the school kids and their parents in an earlier September clean-up in 2010.
