

## BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY Thursday, October 23, 2025 5:00pm in Tracy Hall

Draft minutes

Appellants: Asher Auel; Jeremy Campbell and Andrew Cliburn for Victor P LLC.

- 1. AUEL-RAAB parcel # 15-010.100, 5 Happy Hill Rd.
  - a. Manny re-opened the hearing at 5:03pm.
  - **b.** Leiter read the inspection report into the record.
  - c. Auel reiterated the basis for his appeal and noted that there is only 100amp service in the new addition as far as he's aware. In addition there is a full bath on the second floor that wasn't mentioned in the report. Auel also noted that the sale of his house is outside the three year window examined by KRT.
  - **d.** The Listers stated that they understand the appellant's points; however the assessed value is under what was paid for the property in 2021.
  - **e.** Leiter moved and Baker seconded accepting the inspection report with amendments as follows:
    - i. Remove the sentence about amp service.
    - ii. Correct the number of bathrooms on the second floor to reflect one full and one 34 bath.
    - iii. Refer to it as an Old Style, not cape
  - **f.** Hearing closed at 5:16pm.
- 2. VICTOR P LLC Parcel # 11-068.000, 694 Goodrich Four Corners Rd.
  - a. Manny called the meeting to order at 5:19pm.
  - **b.** Baker read the inspection report into the record.
  - **c.** Cliburn reiterated the substance of his appeal and noted that statutory framework for appeals does not require comparables to be located in the town. He reiterated

- that the cost approach does not does not capture the value of some properties, and believes that the market approach is a better approach in this case.
- **d.** The Listers noted some additions that did not appear on the property record card, including a patio, and additional fixtures found. They proposed a different condition and year for the outbuildings. Smith noted that during the town-wide reappraisal comparables must be found within the town.
- **e.** Manny noted that at the VLCT training you could find comparable properties for your appeal from outside the town.
- f. Leither moved and Scherer seconded accepting the inspection report. Unanimous by roll call vote.
- g. Hearing closed at 5:31pm.
