1. Call to Order

Lindberg called the meeting to order at 11:00am.

2. Review and approval of agenda – discussion/motion

Motion by Ciccotelli (2nd Smith) to approve the agenda as presented. The vote was unanimous.

3. Public Comments --

Lindberg thanked the Listers for their hard work in completing the Abstract to the best of our ability. She also thanked Priscilla Vincent who volunteered to help with stuffing envelopes on Wednesday, June 24 in the Listers office.

4. 2026 Grand list Abstract – review/discussion/motion

Lindberg attended the Selectboard meeting on the evening of June 24, 2026 to inform them that the Listers would be filing the Abstract today. A total of 623 Change of Assessment Letters will go in the mail today along with 163 Current Use letters. In 2026, we have 14 new parcels and 11 veterans. Grievance hearings will begin on July 10, 2026. Anyone wishing to grieve their assessment must inform the Listers in writing no later than 4:30pm on Thursday, July 9, 2026. Anyone may file a grievance even if they didn't receive a Change of Assessment letter as long as the written request for a grievance hearing is received in the Listers office by the deadline. Notice of the grievance period will be posted at the Town Clerk's office, the Tracy Hall bulletin board, the Norwich Post Office, the Norwich Public Library and the Dan & Whit's bulletin board. A notice will also be posted on the Norwich listserv.

Motion by Smith (2nd Ciccotelli) to file the 2026 Grand List Abstract with a municipal grand list value of \$1,261,049,500 and an education grand list value of \$1,260,346,000. The vote was unanimous. Lindberg added that Change of Assessment notice had a letter explaining the various reasons for a change in assessment, which included changes created by the software conversion with over 300 parcels changing by small amounts, data corrections, neighborhood code changes, and removal of the Under Construction code if there is no open permit. The Listers will file the Abstract with the Town Clerk immediately following this meeting.

5. Adjournment

Motion by Ciccotelli (2nd Smith) to adjourn at 11:09am. The vote was unanimous.
